Dear Immaculata High School Parent,

Blessings and best wishes for a successful 2017!

After consultation with the Immaculata Advisory Council and the Parish Finance Committee it has been decided that tuition for the 2017-2018 school year will be \$13,500 for underclassmen and \$13,700 for seniors. This increase of just under 5% is necessary to meet the rising cost of operating the school. We understand that this increase will not be easily managed by some families. Assistance is available through the following sources:

**Assistance from the Diocese of Metuchen:**

*If you are Catholic and registered in a parish within the Diocese of Metuchen* you must apply for assistance online using the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. Assistance for Catholic students is funded through the Foundation for Catholic Education. Please proceed to our school website, [www.immaculatahighschool.org](http://www.immaculatahighschool.org), under the links drop down (top right chain links) select "Tuition Assistance." Here you will find the letter and information from Msgr. Corona, Executive Director, Department of Education, Diocese of Metuchen. Instructions and the "Required Pastor Signature Form" are attached here in English and Spanish. The form must be signed by your Pastor and returned to us for consideration from the Diocese.

**Assistance from Immaculata High School:**

*If you are not Catholic or not registered in a parish within the Diocese of Metuchen* you may apply for assistance using the online application through the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Assistance for these applicants is funded by Immaculata High School. When completing your online application, it is imperative that you indicate your actual religious (non-Catholic) affiliation so that your application is properly routed to Immaculata instead of to the Diocese. Please note, funds are quite limited so prompt and complete applications are extremely important. Student grades, conduct, service and attendance are important assistance considerations.

All applications must be fully completed by March 31, 2017. Those applying for assistance must undertake an agreement of confidentiality, both on the Committee side as well as on the recipient side. All applications and distributions are confidential.

Re-registration paperwork will follow in the days ahead, please return it quickly to aid us in planning for the year to come. Thank you for choosing Immaculata High School for your child/ren and for being a vital part of this thriving community.
