



## TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS For Non-Catholics

These instructions are for families who are not catholic or who are not registered at a parish within the Diocese of Metuchen. If you are Catholic, you must apply for assistance through the Diocese. Please return to “Tools & Information” and read the Assistance Instructions for Catholic Families.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Non-Catholic Student must be entering grades 9–12
- Non-Catholic Student must be registered to attend Immaculata High School

Families applying for tuition assistance will need to complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment (FGAA) online application at <https://online/factsmtg.com/aid>. This online application is viewable in English and Spanish. The application fee is \$30 and must be paid online at the time you submit your application or we will be unable to review your application and award assistance.

All supporting documentation as outlined on the FGAA website must be uploaded in pdf format directly to your application. Documentation may also be faxed to (866) 315-9264. Please be sure to include your Applicant ID number on all faxed documents.
