What is the HSPT?

The High School Placement Test (HSPT) is an assessment used by many Catholic high schools throughout the country and a required part of the admissions process for high schools in the Diocese of Metuchen. The exam is approximately 2½ hours long and will be given to students applying to the Immaculata High School Class of 2022 on Saturday, November 4 (alternate date: Saturday, November 11). The format of the test is multiple choice; there is no essay. Students are tested on reading, sentence completion, verbal skills, spelling and vocabulary, and quantitative skills. Students can only take the HSPT one time so thorough preparation is critical. The HSPT Prep course offered at Immaculata High School prepares students for all areas of the exam.

HSPT Prep Course

When: 5 weeks, September 26, 2017 – October 26, 2017; 10 sessions (see below for session dates)

Time: 4:00pm – 5:00pm

Includes: 10 one-hour sessions, located at IHS; HSPT Prep workbook

Who: Open to 8th graders preparing to take the HSPT in Fall 2017

Class Size: Space is limited – will not exceed 20 students

Why: Students will review the math, reading, vocabulary and grammar skills tested on the HSPT. Students will also learn test-taking strategies to help them feel more confident.

Cost per student: \$200.00

Session Dates: Tuesday 9/26, Thursday 9/28, Tuesday 10/3, Thursday 10/5, Tuesday 10/10, Thursday 10/12, Tuesday 10/17, Thursday 10/19, Tuesday 10/24, and Thursday 10/26
