Re: Out of State Travel during Spring Break 2021

**Updated Tuesday March 23rd.** 

There has been a lot of confusion about Spring Break Travel. Most of this comes from the CDC, NJ DOH, and local Health Departments all having different regulations and recommendations that change based on transmission rates. I also made an error in the earlier correspondence regarding quarantine periods. I apologize. After working with the Somerset County Department of Health and Immaculate Conception School, we are requiring/clarifying the following for students that travel during Spring Break 2021:

- 1. Academic Office: Please inform the Academic office with the dates of travel and specifically the date of return to NJ. The student will be placed on the virtual companion program to complete any required quarantine that is necessary. This notification must be submitted by 3/29/21 to sgasko@immaculatahighschool.org
- 2. Required Quarantine: Currently, the required quarantine for out of state travel (not including the tri-state area) is 7 days from the return of travel. The date of return is day 0. The student may return to school on the 8th day with a NEGATIVE COVID test taken on day 3-5. The Somerset County department of health is recommending a PCR test. Immaculata will need a copy of the NEGATIVE COVID PCR test to return to school on the 8th day. Without the negative PCR test, it will be 10 days with a return to school on the 11th day.
- 3. Positive COVID Students: Students that are COVID positive coming out of the spring break should maintain their quarantine for 10 days. The date of the positive test is day 0. Please notify the school of any positive cases.
