Dear Immaculata High School Parent,

Blessings and best wishes for a successful 2018!

After consultation with the Immaculata Advisory Council and the Parish Finance Committee it has been decided that tuition for the 2018-2019 school year will be \$14,000 for underclassmen and \$14,200 for seniors. This increase of 3.7% is necessary to meet the rising cost of operating the school. We understand that this increase will not be easily managed by some families. Assistance is available through the following sources:

Assistance from the Diocese of Metuchen:

If you are Catholic and registered in a parish within the Diocese of Metuchen you may apply for assistance online using the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. Assistance for Catholic students is funded through the Foundation for Catholic Education. Please proceed to our school website, www.Immaculatahighschool.org, under "About Us" select "Tools & Information." Here you will find the information from Msgr. Corona, Executive Director, Department of Education, Diocese of Metuchen and instructions for completing your Assistance Application through the FACTS Grant & Aid system.

Assistance from Immaculata High School:

If you are not Catholic or not registered in a parish within the Diocese of Metuchen you may apply for assistance using the online application through the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>. Assistance for these applicants is funded by Immaculata High School. When completing your online application, it is imperative that you indicate your actual religious (non-Catholic) affiliation so that your application is properly routed to Immaculata instead of to the Diocese. Please note, funds are quite limited so prompt and complete applications are extremely important.

Student grades, conduct, service and attendance are important for all assistance considerations.

Applications must be fully completed with all supporting documents uploaded by March 31, 2018. Those applying for assistance must undertake an agreement of confidentiality, both on the Committee side as well as on the recipient side. All applications and distributions are confidential.

Re-registration paperwork will follow in the days ahead, please return it quickly to aid us in planning for the year to come. Thank you for choosing Immaculata High School for your child/ren and for being a vital part of this thriving community.
