Scholarships Opportunities for students who have experienced the profound loss of a parent/loved one to suicide

Scholarship requirements are:

> Students need to be continuing their education in a field that aids in Mental Health. Demonstrate an excellent record of academic achievements and community service.

- a) a copy of their academic transcript
- b) a resume highlighting extracurricular activities and community service
- c) one letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor or a teacher
- > Also, students need to submit a <u>500-word essay</u> about their career goals and address the following questions:
 - * Why are they interested in a career in the mental health field?
 - * How has their personal life been impacted by suicide loss?
